2) Borrowing Procedures

- Members in good standing with SIP and residing in BC are eligible for borrowing books and tapes.
- The borrower pays for the cost of mailing both ways and the cheque for the cost of postage is to be enclosed with the video/book when it is returned.
- Loan Period will be 3 weeks for any item, either books or tapes
- You can make your request either by email at <u>library@satirpacific.org</u> or by phone at (604) 634-0572. Contact person is Cindi Mueller, Administrator, Satir Institute of the Pacific, and you can arrange the date for the pickup of your material.
- You can get and return the material to the following place: Satir Institute of the Pacific 13686 – 94A Avenue, Surrey, BC V3V 1N1 Call to make an appointment
- You can renew the item either by email or by phone
- Renewal will be allowed if the material has not been requested by another member
- Renewal is only allowed twice
- The material must be returned after two renewals
- Each member can borrow 2 items at one time
- Fines for overdue will be \$1 per day per item. It can be paid by cheque or cash
- Charge for lost item based on the current cost to replace particular item.
