About The Program:

Since Virginia Satir left us in 1988, Maria Gomori and John Banmen have continued to develop her model in their own unique creative ways. For the last 10 years of Virginia's life Maria and John were senior faculty with Virginia Satir at her month long Process Community in Crested Butte, Colorado. As colleagues and friends of Virginia Satir they were privy to her more private musings and thoughts about human growth and change. With their experiential connection to Satir's Human Growth Model, since her death they have deepened the process of how people change from their spiritual essence.

Before Maria Gomori will work with a star, John Banmen will cover some of the basics of the Satir Model and put into perspective the work ahead. He will cover the intrapsychic and interactive aspects of the process to assist people with limited Satir Model background to understand and appreciate the transformational depth of Maria Gomoris work. Afterwards, he will explain and conceptualize the therapeutic process of the demonstration.

Since 1970 Maria Gomori and John Banmen have worked together in many contexts and in many countries around the world. They are co-authors with Virginia Satir and Jane Gerber of the award winning book *"The Satir Model: Family Therapy and Beyond"* (1991). In 2015 Maria Gomori will celebrate her 95th Birthday and John Banmen will celebrate his 80th Birthday. We are excited to provide this opportunity to witness these two master therapists working together in what will probably be their last workshop as a team in North America.

Workshop Leaders:

Maria Gomori, MSW, Ph.D., RMFT, is internationally known as an author, therapist and educator. Her training programs have taken her into Australia, Asia, Europe, and South and North America. She has authored and co-authored many books on the Satir Model.

Maria Gomori is the Founder and Director of Training of the Satir Professional Development Institute of Manitoba and Emeritus faculty of the Haven Institute on Gabriola Island. She is retired Associate Professor, Department of Psychiatry in the Faculty of Medicine, University of Manitoba. Guest Faculty; Aurora, Marriage and Family Therapy Institute, University of Winnipeg, Manitoba

Maria is the author of "Passion for Freedom: The Life of Maria Gomori", "Personal Alchemy: The Art of Satir Family Reconstruction" with Eleanor Adaskin, "Satir Family Therapy with Maria Gomori" and has co-authored "The Satir Model: Family Therapy and Beyond" and "The Satir Approach to Communication". All of the above books are also published in Chinese, Mandarin and Simplified Chinese.

Maria Gomori is a clinical member and approved supervisor for AAMFT and a family therapist in private practice in Winnipeg.

John Banmen, R. Psych., RMFT is internationally known as an author, therapist and educator. His training programs have taken him to over a dozen countries in Asia, Europe, South America and North America. He has authored and edited several books and articles focusing on the Satir Model.

Dr. Banmen is the founding president of the BC Association for Marriage and Family Therapy, a former member of the Board of Directors of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT), a former member of the Board of Directors of the BC Psychological Association, a former member of the Board of Directors of the International Family Therapy Association, former Director of Training for the Satir Institute of the Pacific and presently the chairman of the Banmen Satir China Management Center.

Dr. Banmen is the author of "The Use of the Satir Model in Treating Suicide Clients"; co-authored "The Satir Model: Family Therapy and Beyond"; editor of "Meditations of Virginia Satir", "Application of the Satir Growth Model", "Satir Transformational Systemic Therapy" and "Virginia Satir... In Her Own Words".

Dr. Banmen was, for four years, honorary Associate Professor at the University of Hong Kong and was on faculty at the University of British Columbia for 21 years. Recently he was appointed visiting (Guest) Professor at Beijing Normal University, China for a five year period. Presently he is putting his effort into expanding the application of the Satir Model in China. He is an Approved Supervisor with AAMFT and provides extensive supervision for counsellors, psychotherapist and family therapists. He also practices privately in Delta, British Columbia, Canada, with individuals and couples in family therapy.
