PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



My hope is that all of you and your families are safe and well during these times of heightened uncertainty resulting from the Covid 19 pandemic. Uncertainty about our own life and our future health and well being is nothing new but part of being human. Although we often strive in many ways to build a sense of security for ourselves and our families, the pandemic reminds us that life is ephemeral and can change in a moment.

Virginia Satir's frequent use in her meditations and elsewhere of phrases like 'at this moment' or 'in this moment of time' reminds us to be present to every moment of our lives. We are all challenged by the loss of the familiar pattern of our own lives and are developing new ways and, perhaps, values for being in the world and relating to others.

The pandemic has also challenged the Satir Institute to rethink, be creative and develop an awareness of new possibilities to adapt the way it fulfills its Mission in the present moment and beyond while maintaining our values.

The immediate challenges for the Board were financial with almost total loss of income and the cancellation of our in-person programs. At the same time it was deemed expedient for our administrator to remain working and to maintain our office in order to maintain our presence and profile, although these are the Institute's major expenses. Fortunately, we have intentionally over the years built up financial reserves to carry us through lean times and be able to launch new initiatives. We are still hopeful that our application for Federal Government assistance will be successful. I believe our financial future is relatively secure.

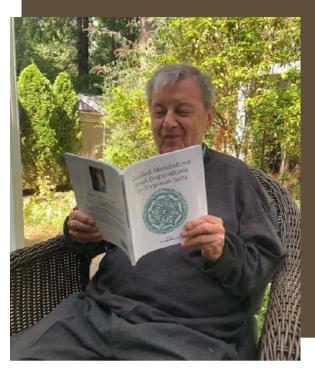
At the same time the challenge was to provide some kind of program of connection and support both for our members and those who have trained with SIP presenters here and abroad. We are grateful to Linda Lucas and Jennifer Nagel who stepped up and hosted a weekly meeting on Zoom with a reading, a meditation, a short teaching piece and an opportunity to discuss some topics in trios before ending with some sharing in the large group.



On average about thirty people attended each week from many countries which added to the rich experience. It is intended that these meetings will continue on a monthly schedule with other members gaining experience as hosts. We are pleased to be offering two short programs using Zoom on 'Grief, Loss and Change' in August (completed) and 'Freedom through Forgiveness' in October. This will be followed by 'STST Foundations Part 1' using Zoom, also beginning in September and ending in January 2021. An 'STST Foundations Part 2" is in the planning stage. Thanks to the generosity of Dr. John Banmen we are pleased to be able to publish a new book of Meditations and Inspirations of Virginia Satir which is now available from our office.

The Board is excited about the new possibilities that have emerged to fulfill our Mission and are determined to continue to make a difference by bringing 'Peace within, Peace between and Peace among' particularly during this time of global uncertainty.
